

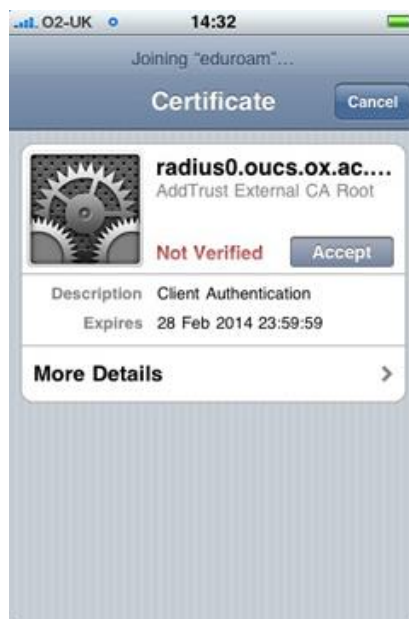
## Connecting to Eduroam via Android

1. **Select All programs**  
**Settings**  
**Wireless controls**  
**Wi-Fi settings**  
**Wi-Fi (turn on Wi-Fi)**  
**Select Eduroam**
2. **EAP type – select PEAP**
3. **Change the Sub-type to PEAPV0/MSCHAPv2 (this should be the default)**
4. **Enter your username followed by @sgul.ac.uk and password.**  
(N.B. On some mobiles you may see an Anonymous identity box – leave this blank).
5. **Hit Connect.**
6. **“Connected to eduroam” should appear**



## Connecting to Eduroam via an iPhone or iPod touch

1. Turn on wireless ([Settings] then [Wi-Fi]). You should see a list of available wireless networks.
2. Select [eduroam].
3. Enter your username followed by @sgul.ac.uk (for example helpdesk@sgul.ac.uk) and your password.
4. The certificate will be shown; click Accept



5. You will be returned to the Wi-Fi Networks screen; this should show that you are now connected to Eduroam.
