QR (Quick Response) codes are a type of barcode that you can scan with a QR Reader app on your mobile device to quickly and easily connect to a webpage or file etc.

Using QR codes is as easy as 1,2,3...

STEP 1

Open your QR Code reader*

STEP 2

Scan the QR code

STEP 3

Your mobile/tablet will find the website/e-book etc.
